

I'm a Christian Now! is a three-part mandatory class that helps children understand what it means to be a Christian. The focus is children, in **grades one through four**, who have already made a profession of faith. With the help of their parent(s) at home, children complete an interactive workbook describing the steps of salvation, the purpose of the church, prayer, and Christian service. Following this study, children are encouraged to follow the Lord's example in baptism.

Stonebriar's *Preteen Baptism Class* is designed for children in the **fifth or sixth grade** who are preparing for baptism. This two-part class, usually from 7–8 p.m., helps preteens understand what baptism means and why followers of Christ should be baptized.
