College Campus Connections

- Develop relationships with key campus staff in order to open relationships with students.

Flagship Events

- Innovate significant experiences for connection and spiritual growth, such as retreats and conferences.

Small Groups

- In collaboration with the Equipping Ministries team, build life-changing small groups where young adults can grow in their relationship with Jesus and one another.

Multigenerational Mentoring

- Recruit and develop a team of mentors for both College and Young Adults ministries. These mentors should be faithful men and women who are open and authentic about themselves and their experiences, who are willing to share their lives with others.

Missional Pursuits

- In alignment with our church's Missional Living ministries, cast a passionate vision for meaningful mission with clear opportunities for serving others inside and outside our church.

Leadership Teams and Mentors

- Build up Ministry Partners (volunteers) who serve, lead, and mentor young adults in relational discipleship, both one-on-one and in small groups.

Preaching and Teaching

- As a unified part of the contemporary service preaching team, collaborate on the planning and preaching of sermon series.
- Prepare for opportunities as needed to teach classes and facilitate small groups.

General Pastoral Ministry Responsibilities

- Forecast, budget, and obtain appropriate approvals in order to fund the ministry.
- Provide ongoing ministry evaluation, considering the overall church strategy and ministry.
- Actively engage in strategic ministry planning with the Equipping Ministries team, and interdepartmentally as needed.
- Be aware of recovery ministry needs in the young adult ministry, and, as needed, proactively engage in collaboration with our Care Ministries team.
- Care for and nurture this area of ministry as well as shared churchwide pastoral care (phone and web inquiries, pastoral guidance, and ministry rosters—baptisms, weddings, funerals, hospital visitation, and the after-hours pastor-on-call phone).
- Be available by cell phone outside regular office hours.
