Job Title: Ministry Leader—Special Needs (GIFT Ministry)

Reports To: Lead Pastoral Leader of Special Needs and Senior Adult Ministries

**Ministry Purpose:** Love God, Love Others by upholding the ministry values of Stonebriar Community Church (SCC), cultivating intimacy with God, and leading others toward Christian maturity.

## **Ministry Responsibilities:**

Including but not limited to the following:

## GIFT Life (SCC's life-skills program for adults with special needs)

- Restart program to serve 12–15 students during one half-day class.
- Create and execute a growth plan toward offering multiple classes in order to serve many students from Frisco and nearby communities.
- Manage program:
  - Recruit, train, schedule, empower, and support ministry partners (volunteers) and any staff members hired as the program expands.
  - Work with the GIFT Life team to plan activities and events around the values that God has designed for each of us to worship, learn, and serve.
  - Manage registrations through Ministry Platform and communicate thoroughly with all persons involved.
  - Manage space reservations and work orders through eSPACE.

#### Sundays, Events, and Activities

- Manage GIFT classrooms and monitor inclusion students on Sunday mornings per rotation schedule.
- Help the GIFT team as they plan and supervise annual events.
- Recognize opportunities for GIFT families to participate in churchwide and other ministries' activities.
- Continually look for new ministry partners and direct them toward the GIFT team to pursue.

#### **Communication and Care**

- Serve as an advocate both within the church and outside the church for those with special needs and their families.
- Be available by cell phone/email outside of regular office hours for more urgent issues (phone stipend provided).
- Attend weekly GIFT team meetings and share updates, opportunities to research, and issues to be resolved that improve our service to our GIFT families and strengthen our GIFT team.
- Answer basic questions about the church's faith and connect those needing help with a pastor or ministry leader; follow up as needed.

- Coordinate and communicate with supervisor regarding responsibilities to be managed on site or remotely.
- Provide care and concern for GIFT students, families, ministry partners, and Stonebriar staff, providing appropriate resources and/or praying with someone if requested.
