


OUR KING has come.

Think about why Jesus came to earth. What did He come to do?

Jesus' purpose was prophesied for generations and proclaimed at His birth. As the angel said to the shepherds, "Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; He is the Messiah, the Lord." (Luke 2:11, NIV)

A perfect life. As foretold, our King was born into time, growing and learning, teaching, ministering, and healing—an innocent man now scourged, beaten, and suffering amidst a crowd of scoffers. As Jesus hung on the cross, His last guttural cry was, "My God, why have You forsaken Me?" Being coeternal with the Father and the Spirit, Jesus had known unity and Oneness. He cried out because He was experiencing what is rightfully due to all of sinful mankind—separation from God.

Though man has attempted to communicate the horrors of Hell through word and paint, the starkest explanation is an existence without the presence of God. Think upon what God is. Hope. Deliverance. Love. Righteousness. Joy. Peace.

Without Him, there is no deliverance. No end to pain and suffering. No escape. No light to break the darkness. Jesus willingly entered this shadow—a true death suffered so that we would not have to. He did it knowingly and willingly, a sacrifice of love made so that people would never need to suffer the absence of God.
