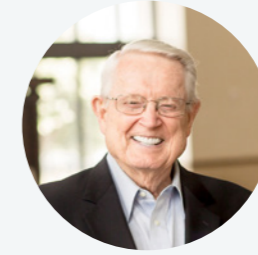

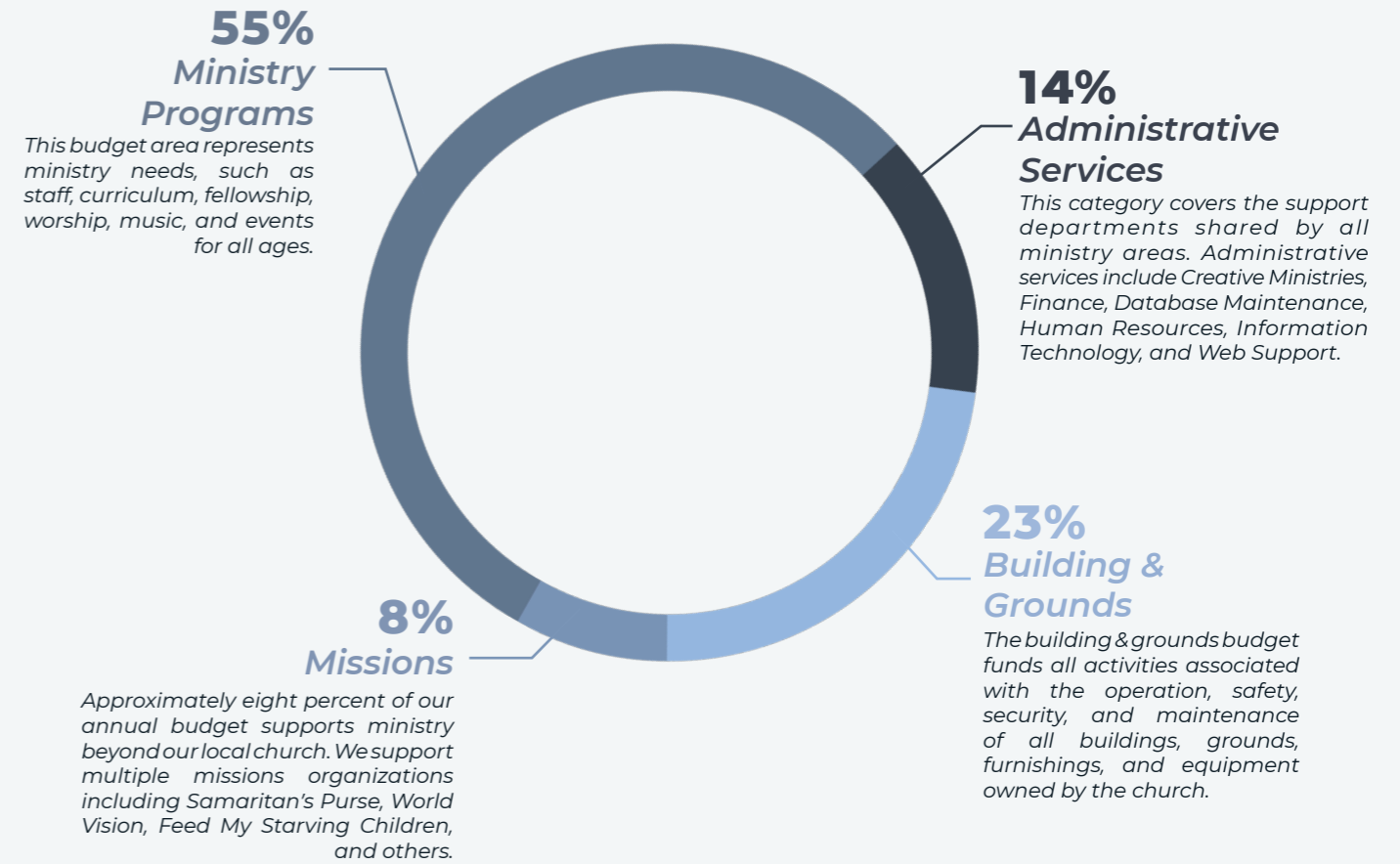
# FINANCIAL REPORT

## Direction and Control

The Finance Department, with a staff of five, reports to Don McMinn, Senior Associate Pastor of Arts and Administration. Our Finance Committee, composed of Stonebriar members and one elder, meets quarterly to review financial reports and recommend financial direction and actions to the elders.

An annual audit is performed by an independent audit firm, PSK. Our auditors consistently affirm the integrity with which we handle our finances.

The annual budget is composed by the staff, submitted to the Finance Committee for review, and approved by the elders. Our fiscal year is July 1–June 30.

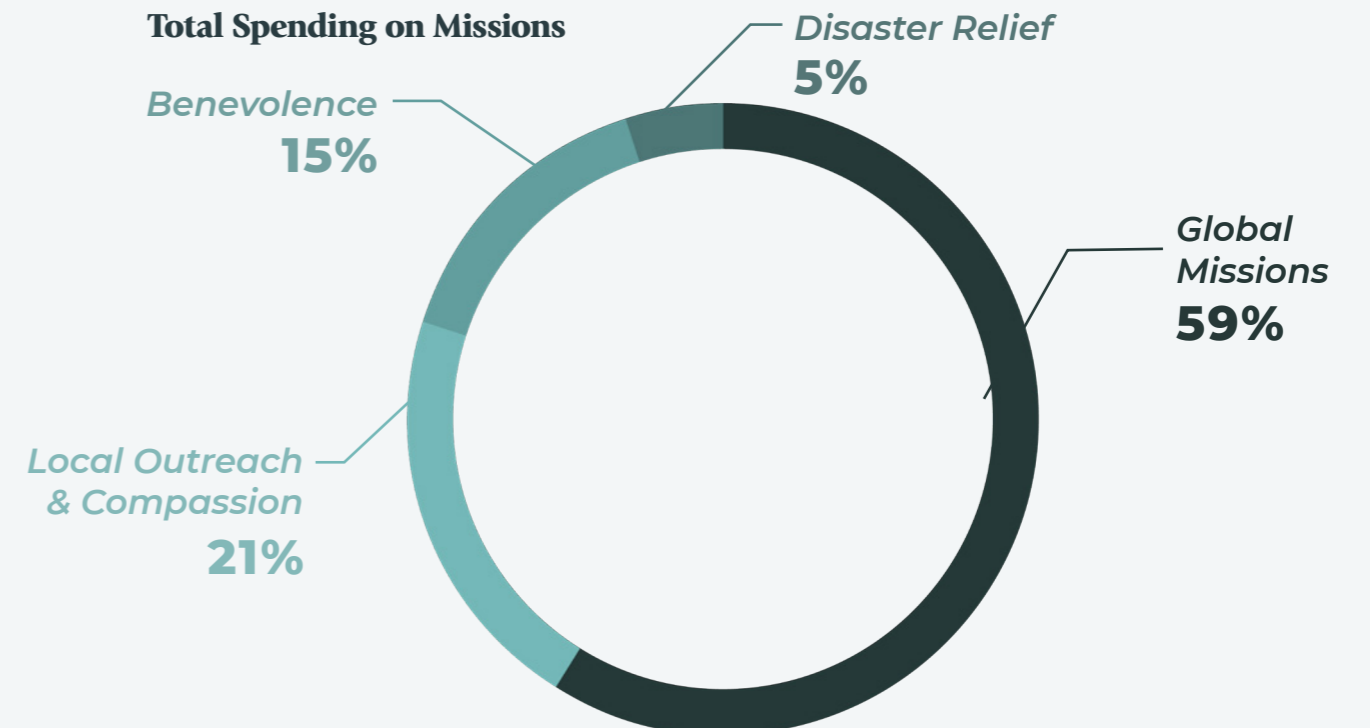
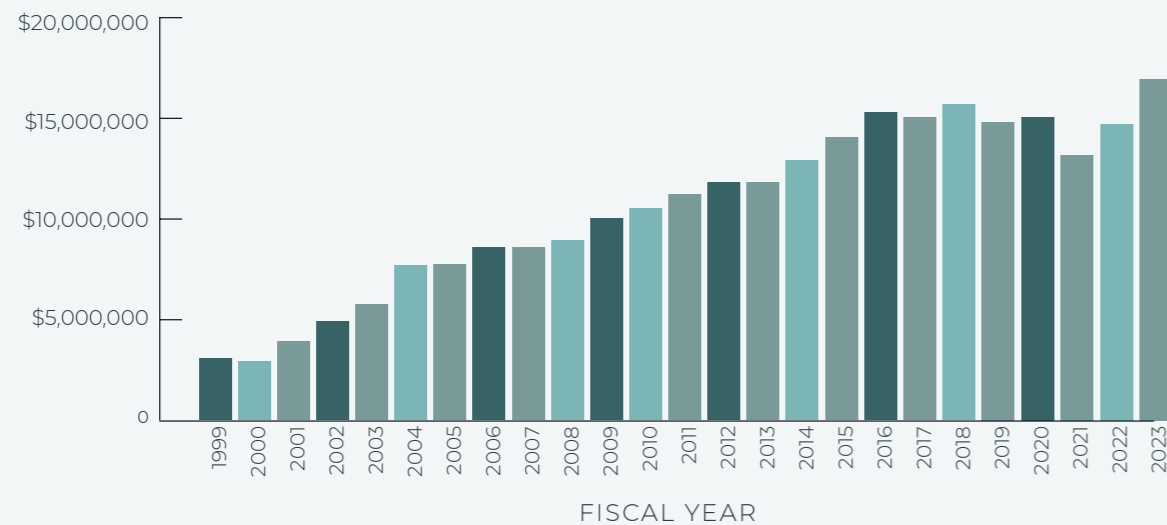

## Additional \$101,900 Donated for Benevolence

As part of caring for our community, our church offers a Benevolence Ministry to assist local families who are facing financial hardship. With special offerings received five or six times annually, our Benevolence Ministry collected \$101,900 outside our general fund budget in 2022, allowing us to assist more than 100 families with short-term and emergency needs. Beyond financial assistance, our Benevolence Ministry also provides budget coaching and care teams (led by staff from our Care Ministries) to help families acquire the skills needed to make a lasting difference in their lives.
