

## Dr. Howard Hendricks Memorial Scholarships 2019

The following scholarships are endowed by the generosity of Mrs. Jeanne Hendricks in memory of Dr. Howard Hendricks. Two scholarships are awarded in the amount of \$1500 at the end of each school year to one male and one female graduate.

Applications made by students in 12<sup>th</sup> grade who follow the General Application Criteria outlined below will be considered for awards. Scholarship winners will be announced in the church worship services on the day we recognize the current graduating class (May 19<sup>th</sup>).

General Application Criteria:

- Application deadline is **5:00 pm, April 22nd**; application must be received in the Stonebriar Community Church office or drop box across from the HUB by this deadline and must be complete to be considered.
- Scholarships are character-based not need based; in other words, students must have demonstrated consistent Christ-like character and have strong references attesting to such.
- Essays are not necessary, but the application questions will require thoughtful short answers.
- Applicant may submit only the two required letters of recommendation; additional letters will not be considered. (Be sure to notify the people writing the recommendation of the application deadline.)

## Dr. Howard Hendricks Memorial Scholarship

### Specific Criteria and Application

Dr. Howard Hendricks (1924-2013) was a beloved member and elder of our Stonebriar Community Church family. After coming to know the Lord as Savior and being called to ministry, Dr. Hendricks committed more than sixty years of his life to the craft of teaching and training pastors and ministry leaders at Dallas Theological Seminary. Dr. Hendricks founded the seminary's Christian Education Department, the Center for Christian Leadership, and over the course of his ministry career authored multiple books and publications. He was personally involved in mentoring some of the most significant pastors and Christian leaders of the last sixty years, such as Chuck Swindoll, Tony Evans, Chip Ingram, and Jim Elliot. To his beloved students, he was simply known as "Prof." For all his achievements, Dr. Hendricks had two great passions; teaching students to study the Scriptures with diligence, skill, and passion, and being with his family and the love of his life, his wife Jeanne. In honor of her great love for him and his passion for education, Jeanne Hendricks established the Hendricks Memorial Scholarship so that students from Stonebriar Community Church could continue their pursuit of higher education.

## **Hendricks Memorial Scholarship criteria:**

1. 12th Grade Student
2. Demonstration of consistent Christ-like character
3. Currently involved in Stonebriar Student Ministry (SSM)

### **Application Steps:**

1. Return this completed form, short answer responses and recommendation letters to the church office by Monday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> at 5pm.
  - a. Describe your faith journey and how you will use a Hendricks Memorial Scholarship to achieve your spiritual, personal and academic goals.
  - b. How have you demonstrated your commitment to Stonebriar Community Church and the Student Ministry program?
  - c. Briefly describe your work and/or volunteer history.
2. Recommendation Letters – (should not be completed by relatives)
  - a. One recommendation from someone in the community (outside Stonebriar) which describes the student's work ethic and Christ-like character.
  - b. One recommendation from a mentor or influential adult (not Student Ministry Staff but within Stonebriar) describing the applicant's desire to make a difference for Christ.

References may submit recommendations separately; however, they must specify their relationship to the applicant and be submitted by Monday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> at 5pm.

A blind panel will review all applications and recipients will be chosen based on - 50% participation in SSM and 50% short answers responses and recommendation letters.
